Rules and Regulations for School/Youth Groups

GROUP LEADERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE BEHAVIOR OF THEIR GROUPS AT ALL TIMES.

- Visitors to the Museum of American Finance (the “Museum”) are strictly prohibited from touching any of the artifacts, artworks, exhibits, displays or display cases (except where expressly permitted). Please do not lean on or touch showcases to avoid moving or tipping them.
- No vandalism. It is illegal to deface, damage, mutilate or destroy the Museum property, artifacts, exhibits or equipment, including altering or tampering with computers or software.
- Only pencils may be used in the galleries; the use of pens and markers is strictly prohibited.
- Food, drinks and gum are strictly prohibited in the Museum.
- Running, rough play, fighting, provoking a fight, or engaging in disorderly or boisterous conduct is strictly prohibited.
- Offensive, abusive or threatening language or behavior is strictly prohibited.
- Large bags, such as backpacks, and umbrellas are not permitted in the galleries. Coats, umbrellas and bags may be left in the self service coat and bag check area. **THE MUSEUM WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE, LOSS OR THEFT TO PERSONAL PROPERTY.**
- Flash photography is prohibited in the galleries. Visitors may take pictures for personal use only.
- No firearms or weapons are permitted anywhere on the Museum property.
- Visitors must wear proper attire (as determined by Museum personnel in their sole discretion) while on the Museum property. Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
- Display of profane, obscene or injurious language, texts or graphics for public view is prohibited. Visitors displaying such language on clothing will be asked to either change the garment, or otherwise cover the offensive image/language, or leave the Museum property.
- Visitors must follow the instructions of security officers in the galleries..
- Teachers and other adult chaperones must not leave minor children unattended. At least one (1) chaperone is required for every ten (10) children.
- The Museum reserves the right to refuse or dismiss any group for misconduct. Failure to adhere to the rules and regulations of the Museum, or any misconduct by one or more students in the group, could result in the immediate ejection of the entire group from the Museum property, in the Museum’s sole discretion, without reimbursement of any costs or fees.
- **THE MUSEUM RESERVES THE RIGHT, AT ANY TIME AND FOR ANY REASON OR NO REASON AT ALL, TO CHANGE OR MODIFY THESE RULES, OR IMPLEMENT ADDITIONAL AND/OR MORE RESTRICTIVE RULES AND REGULATIONS THAN THOSE CONTAINED HEREIN.**
